20 WHEREAS, Dedicated to serving his fellow citizens, 21 Mr. Thomas is a veteran of the U.S. Army Reserve and a member of the 22 Texas State Guard; he was employed in state government for 25 years 23 and held top executive positions in a number of agencies; following 24 his retirement in 2009, he embarked on a new career, and he now

serves as senior advisor to top management of a national health care consulting services corporation; he holds a bachelor's degree in psychology and sociology and a master's degree in management and administrative sciences from The University of Texas; for more than 15 years, he taught management courses at Austin Community College; and
