R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Students from Happy High School distinguished
2 themselves through their participation in the 2019 University
3 Interscholastic League Track & Field State Meet; and

4 WHEREAS, Joining the other top high school competitors in
5 Texas at Mike A. Myers Stadium in Austin on May 10 and 11, the Happy
6 High contingent included Justin Bressler, Jackson Davis, Kenli
7 Johnson, Emily Berry, Rylee Johnson, Abigail Drake, Bailee
8 Baggerman, Karla Mayes, and Daisy Berry; the girls' relay teams
9 enjoyed tremendous success, with Kenli Johnson, Emily Berry, Rylee
10 Johnson, and Ms. Drake taking gold in the 1A 4x100-meter event,
11 Ms. Baggerman, Emily Berry, Kenli Johnson, and Rylee Johnson
12 finishing first in the 4x400-meter relay, and Ms. Baggerman,
13 Ms. Mayes, Daisy Berry, and Ms. Drake earning sixth place in the
14 4x200-meter relay; the individual winners included Mr. Davis, who
15 placed first in the boys' high jump and the 400-meter dash and also
16 finished sixth in the 200-meter dash and seventh in the triple jump;
17 additionally, Rylee Johnson took the crown in the girls' 400-meter
18 dash, Mr. Bressler won a silver medal in the boys' pole vault, Kenli
19 Johnson came in third in the girls' 800-meter run, and Emily Berry
20 finished sixth in the girls' 200-meter dash; and
