2 Volunteer Fire Department, was named the department's Fireman of
3 the Year in December 2018; and

6 Bernie Lannom, and two uncles were early members of the department
7 after its reorganization, and they were later joined by Mr. Lannom,

10 department, Mr. Lannom previously served as chief and assistant
11 chief; he is a three-time recipient of the Fireman of the Year

15 lives and property of the citizens of Fort Stockton and Pecos
