R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, In her service as Capitol nurse practitioner during
2 the 86th Legislative Session, Ginger McGalin has skillfully
3 attended to the health care needs of the legislative community; and

4 WHEREAS, A native Texan, Ms. McGalin began serving in the
5 United States Navy Reserve as a hospital corpsman in 1986, and she
6 remained enlisted while undertaking nursing studies at Lamar
7 University in Beaumont, where she graduated with a bachelor's
8 degree in May 1993; she subsequently accepted a commission as a Navy
9 Nurse Corps officer and continued in that role until retiring from
10 active duty in 1996; and

11 WHEREAS, Following her discharge, Ms. McGalin earned her
12 master's degree and completed her education as a family nurse
13 practitioner at The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston
14 in December 1998; over the years, she has been employed in a variety
15 of settings, including clinics, hospitals, nursing homes, and state
16 prison infirmaries, and she also served as the Jefferson County
17 Employee Health nurse practitioner; and

18 WHEREAS, Ms. McGalin began her work as Capitol nurse
19 practitioner in October 2018, and she has since provided care to
20 elected officials and state employees who work in the Capitol
21 Complex, as well as to citizens who are visiting; in addition, she
22 has volunteered as preceptor for nurse practitioner students from
23 UT Austin and from online universities; her outside interests
24 include horses, travel, and photography, and above all else, she

1 cherishes spending time with her twin daughters, Jordyn and Jaedyn;

4 legislative session, Ginger McGalin has helped to ensure the
5 well-being and productivity of the legislative community, and her
