

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The girls' track & field team from Legacy
2 Preparatory Christian Academy in The Woodlands reached the pinnacle
3 of success by winning the 3A title at the 2019 Texas Association of
4 Private and Parochial Schools Track & Field Championships, held on
5 May 3 and 4 in Waco; and

6 WHEREAS, The Lady Lions finished first after compiling a
7 total of 92 points, besting their closest competitor, Sacred Heart
8 Catholic School, by 16 points; and

9 WHEREAS, Legacy Prep received valuable contributions from
10 its relay teams, starting with an early victory in the 4x100-meter
11 relay as the quartet of Margaret Tautfest, Grace Hopkins, Avery
12 Davis, and Bethany Hopkins clocked in at 51.31 seconds; the
13 4x200-meter relay squad of Madison Steed, Ms. Tautfest, Ms. Davis,
14 and Bethany Hopkins also won gold, combining for a time of 1 minute,
15 48.54 seconds; the Lady Lions earned another podium appearance in
16 the 4x400-meter relay, with the team of Layla Faysal, Grace
17 Hopkins, Ms. Steed, and Ms. Tautfest finishing at 4 minutes, 23.40
18 seconds, to claim third; and

19 WHEREAS, In individual events, Caroline Freeman won the
20 silver medal in the 3,200-meter run, crossing the finish line in 12
21 minutes, 43.33 seconds, and Bethany Hopkins placed second in the
22 100-meter dash with a time of 12.58 seconds; throughout the season,
23 the Lady Lions benefited from the able guidance of head coach Wade
24 Hopkins and assistant coaches Casey Clark and Michael Morrow; and

1 WHEREAS, The members of the Legacy Prep Christian Academy
2 girls' track & field team have excelled through skill, hard work,
3 and an enduring commitment to perform at the highest level, and they
4 are a source of tremendous pride to their classmates and their many
5 supporters in the local community; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
7 Legislature hereby congratulate the Legacy Preparatory Christian
8 Academy girls' track & field team on winning the 2019 TAPPS 3A state
