6 Mike A. Myers Stadium in Austin on May 10 and 11, Ms. Hedrick turned
7 in a notable performance, claiming the 3,200-meter title in 11

9 of 5 minutes, 17.76 seconds; this is the second consecutive year
10 that she has been crowned champion in both events; and
