1 WHEREAS, The observance of Constitution Day on September 17, 2 2020, commemorates the signing of our nation's foundational 3 document; and

WHEREAS, On September 17, 1787, the course of history was forever altered by the 39 delegates who added their names to the constitution, the world's oldest written national charter of government; it provided the framework for our republic, and its opening words, "We the People," affirmed that citizens hold the responsibility for determining the course of their country; and

10 WHEREAS, The framers of the constitution, in their great 11 wisdom, separated and balanced governmental powers to safeguard the 12 principles of majority rule and minority rights, the ideals of 13 liberty and equality, and the interests of the federal and state 14 governments; and

15 WHEREAS, Creating a republic representative form of first three articles of the constitution 16 government, the established the separate legislative, executive, and judicial 17 branches, each limited in power by a system of checks and balances; 18 the 10 amendments known as the Bill of Rights were added two years 19 after the signing of the constitution in order to guarantee 20 21 specific civil liberties; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Congress passed a bill in 2004 designating September 17 as Constitution Day and requiring that schools teach students about the vital role of the constitution in our society;

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas 10 Legislature hereby recognize September 17, 2020, as Constitution 11 Day and encourage all Texans to learn more about the many ways in 12 which the U.S. Constitution continues to shape our lives.
