1 WHEREAS, Sarah Beth Lively, a tireless supporter of students 2 in the Austin Independent School District, received well-deserved recognition when the district's board of trustees voted on December 3 17, 2018, to rename Fulmore Middle School in her honor; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Having worked as an associate editor with The University of Texas at Austin, Mrs. Lively began her career in 6 7 education in the 1960s, when she accepted a teaching position at Fulmore; during an exceptional tenure with the school that spanned 8 9 a quarter century, she inspired countless American history students with her lessons on advocacy and civic engagement; she also led the 10 11 Fulmore journalism program, and numerous yearbooks and newspapers 12 created under her guidance won University Interscholastic League competitions and Columbia Scholastic Press Association awards; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Though she officially retired in the early 1990s, Mrs. Lively remained active in the school for more than two 15 decades, visiting the campus on a daily basis and serving as a 16 volunteer journalism teacher; and 17 WHEREAS, Admired for her inclusive and engaging teaching 18 style, Mrs. Lively received the Edith Fox King Award from the 19 Interscholastic League Press Conference in 1986, and after she 20 retired, the Sarah Lively Award for Excellence in Scholastic 21 22 Journalism was established to recognize outstanding Fulmore 23 students at the eighth-grade graduation ceremony each year; and 24 WHEREAS, Sarah Lively has touched the lives of several
