1           WHEREAS, Ken Levine retired as director of the Texas Sunset  
2 Commission on August 31, 2018, drawing to a close an exemplary  
3 career that spanned 37 years with the agency; and

4           WHEREAS, Hired in 1981, Mr. Levine was instrumental in the  
5 development of numerous proposals to improve government operations  
6 and programs through Sunset Commission recommendations; he  
7 supervised policy evaluation projects for all state agencies in  
8 myriad areas; after serving as assistant director, he was appointed  
9 deputy director in 1995, and 14 years later, he was tapped to lead  
10 the agency; and

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Levine is a fellow of the Public Policy Dispute  
12 Resolution Center of The University of Texas School of Law; during  
13 one of three terms on the National Legislative Program Evaluation  
14 Society Executive Committee, he served as its chair; he has also  
15 been a member of the Legislative Staff Coordinating Committee and  
16 vice chair of the standing committee on Budget and Revenue for the  
17 National Conference on State Legislatures; a graduate of The  
18 University of Texas at Austin, he holds a master's degree from the  
19 institution's LBJ School of Public Affairs; and

20           WHEREAS, Through his exemplary leadership, professionalism,  
21 and steadfast commitment to good governance, Ken Levine greatly  
22 benefited his fellow Texans, and he may indeed reflect with pride on  
23 a career well spent; now, therefore, be it
