1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 2 Texas, 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, 3 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 891 (the operation and administration of and practice in and grants provided by courts in 6 7 the judicial branch of state government; increasing and imposing fees; creating a criminal offense) to consider and take action on 8 9 the following matter:

House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4) is suspended to permit the committee to add text on a matter not included in either the house or senate version of the bill by adding the following new SECTION to ARTICLE 13 of the bill:

SECTION 13.01. Section 231.103(a), Family Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The Title IV-D agency may:

charge a reasonable application fee;

(2) charge a $\frac{$35}{[$25]}$ annual service fee; and

19 (3) to the extent permitted by federal law, recover20 costs for the services provided in a Title IV-D case.

Explanation: The addition is necessary to amend the Family Code to provide for an increase of the annual service fee charged by the Title IV-D agency.
