- 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
- 4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
- 5 resolve the differences on House Bill 2327 (preauthorization of
- 6 certain medical care and health care services by certain health
- 7 benefit plan issuers and to the regulation of utilization review,
- 8 independent review, and peer review for health benefit plan and
- 9 workers' compensation coverage) to consider and take action on the
- 10 following matter:
- House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit the
- 12 conference committee to amend text not in disagreement in proposed
- 13 SECTION 3.02 of the bill, in the transition language, to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 SECTION 3.02. The changes in law made by Article 2 of this
- 16 Act apply only to utilization, independent, or peer review
- 17 requested on or after September 1, 2020. Utilization, independent,
- 18 or peer review requested before September 1, 2020, is governed by
- 19 the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this
- 20 Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 Explanation: The change is necessary to delay the
- 22 implementation of Article 2 of the bill by a year.
