- 6 fever and respiratory distress; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Seven-year-old Jakelin Caal Maquin died on December
- 8 8, 2018, in El Paso of a bacterial infection; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Felipe Alonzo Gómez, age eight, died on Christmas
- 10 Eve in El Paso from Influenza B and a bacterial infection; and
- WHEREAS, On April 30, 2019, Juan de León Gutiérrez, age 16,
- 12 died in El Paso from a brain infection; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Two-year-old Wilmer Josué Ramírez Vázquez of
- 14 Guatemala died in El Paso on May 14, after being diagnosed with
- 15 pneumonia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, At the Weslaco Border Patrol Station, 16-year-old
- 17 Carlos Gregorio Hernandez Vazquez, who was diagnosed with Influenza
- 18 A, died on May 20; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The United States has long been a beacon of liberty,
- 20 justice, and opportunity, and the loss of these six young lives
- 21 reminds us that our nation's ideals exert a powerful pull on those
- 22 hoping for a better life; now, therefore, be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
