## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the provision of informational materials and certain
- 3 other information to a pregnant woman before an abortion.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 171.012, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (f) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) The information required to be provided under
- 9 Subsections (a)(1) and (2) may not be provided by audio or video
- 10 recording and must be provided at least 24 hours before the abortion
- 11 is to be performed:
- 12 (1) orally and in person in a private and confidential
- 13 setting if the pregnant woman currently lives less than 100 miles
- 14 from the nearest abortion provider that is a facility licensed
- 15 under Chapter 245 or a facility that performs more than 50 abortions
- 16 in any 12-month period; or
- 17 (2) orally by telephone on a private call or in person
- 18 in a private and confidential setting if the pregnant woman
- 19 certifies that the woman currently lives 100 miles or more from the
- 20 nearest abortion provider that is a facility licensed under Chapter
- 21 245 or a facility that performs more than 50 abortions in any
- 22 12-month period.
- 23 (f) The physician who is to perform the abortion, or the
- 24 physician's designee, shall in person hand to the pregnant woman a

- 1 copy of the informational materials described by Section 171.014:
- 2 (1) on the day of the consultation required under
- 3 Subsection (a)(4) for a pregnant woman who lives less than 100 miles
- 4 from the nearest abortion provider that is a facility licensed
- 5 under Chapter 245 or a facility in which more than 50 abortions are
- 6 performed in any 12-month period; or
- 7 (2) before any sedative or anesthesia is administered
- 8 to the pregnant woman on the day of the abortion and at least two
- 9 hours before the abortion if the woman lives 100 miles or more from
- 10 the nearest abortion provider that is a facility licensed under
- 11 Chapter 245 or a facility in which more than 50 abortions are
- 12 performed in any 12-month period.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 171.012, Health and Safety Code, as
- 14 amended by this Act, applies only to an abortion performed on or
- 15 after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
