5	SECTION 1. Subchapter M, Chapter 56, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 56.3051 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 56.3051. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS. A
8	person may not receive a TEXAS grant for more than the lesser of:
9	(1) 135 semester credit hours or the equivalent; or
10	(2) 15 semester credit hours, or the equivalent, in
11	addition to the number of credit hours needed to complete the
12	student's degree program.
13	SECTION 2. Section 56.307(j), Education Code, is amended to
14	read as follows:
15	(j) A public institution of higher education shall use other
16	available sources of financial aid, other than a loan or work study,
17	to cover any difference in the amount of a TEXAS grant awarded to
18	the student and the actual amount of tuition and required fees at
19	the institution if the difference results from:
20	(1) a reduction in the amount of a TEXAS grant under
21	Subsection (i-1); or
22	(2) a deficiency in the amount of the grant as
23	established under Subsection (a) or (e), as applicable, to cover
24	the full amount of tuition and required fees charged to the student

SECTION 3. Section 56.304(d), Education Code, is repealed. 2 3 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply beginning with initial or subsequent TEXAS grants awarded for the 4 2019 fall semester. Initial or subsequent TEXAS grants awarded for 5 6 a semester or term before the 2019 fall semester are governed by the applicable law in effect immediately before the effective date of 7 this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that 8 9 purpose.

10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
