- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 443.0134 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 443.0134. PLACE TO EXPRESS BREAST MILK. The board
- 8 shall provide in the Capitol a place, other than a bathroom, that is
- 9 shielded from view and free from intrusion of any person where a
- 10 member of the public or an employee can express breast milk.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 619.004, Government Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- Sec. 619.004. PUBLIC EMPLOYER RESPONSIBILITIES. (a) A
- 14 public employer shall:
- 15 (1) provide a reasonable amount of break time for an
- 16 employee to express breast milk each time the employee has need to
- 17 express the milk; and
- 18 (2) provide a place, other than a [multiple user]
- 19 bathroom, that is shielded from view and free from intrusion from
- 20 other employees and the public where the employee can express
- 21 breast milk.
- (b) A public employer that engages in or contracts for the
- 23 construction or renovation of any building open to the public in
- 24 which the public employer is housed shall ensure that the building

- 1 includes a publicly accessible place, other than a bathroom, that
- 2 is shielded from view and free from intrusion of another person
- 3 where a member of the public can express breast milk.
- 4 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 5 of this Act, the State Preservation Board shall establish in the
- 6 Capitol a place for a person to express breast milk as required by
- 7 Section 443.0134, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 619.004(b), Government Code, as added by
- 9 this Act, applies only to the construction or renovation of a
- 10 building open to the public in which a public employer is housed
- 11 that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
