- 6 SECTION 1. STUDY REGARDING METHODS AND STANDARDS TO
- 7 EVALUATE CERTAIN STUDENTS. (a) The Texas Education Agency shall
- 8 conduct a study regarding appropriate methods and standards to
- 9 evaluate the performance, separately from the performance of other
- 10 students attending the district or campus in which the program is
- 11 physically located, of a student who spends at least 50 percent of
- 12 the instructional day participating in a regional day school
- 13 program for the deaf under Subchapter D, Chapter 30, Education
- 14 Code, and whose parent or person standing in parental relation to
- 15 the student does not reside in the school district providing
- 16 program services.
- 17 (b) Not later than September 1, 2020, the Texas Education
- 18 Agency shall provide a report of the study required by Subsection
- 19 (a) of this section and any recommendations for legislative action
- 20 to each standing committee of the legislature having primary
- 21 jurisdiction over public education.
- (c) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- 23 SECTION 2. IMPLEMENTATION. The Texas Education Agency is
- 24 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the

- 1 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If
- 2 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 3 purpose, the Texas Education Agency may, but is not required to,
- 4 implement a provision of this Act using other appropriations
- 5 available for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 7 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 8 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 9 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 10 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
