1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to personal information that may be omitted from certain
 1-22 records and licenses.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 11.008(a), Property Code, is amended to
 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (a) In this section, "instrument" means a deed, ~~or~~ deed of
 1-27 trust, or any other record recorded by a county clerk related to
 1-28 real property, including a mineral lease, a mechanic's lien, and
 1-29 the release of a mechanic's lien.

1-30 SECTION 2. Section 25.025(b), Tax Code, is amended to read
 1-31 as follows:

1-32 (b) Information in appraisal records under Section 25.02 is
 1-33 confidential and is available only for the official use of the
 1-34 appraisal district, this state, the comptroller, and taxing units
 1-35 and political subdivisions of this state if:

1-36 (1) the information identifies the home address of a
 1-37 named individual to whom this section applies; and

1-38 (2) the individual:

1-39 (A) chooses to restrict public access to the
 1-40 information on the form prescribed for that purpose by the
 1-41 comptroller under Section 5.07; or

1-42 (B) is a federal or state judge ~~[as defined by~~
 1-43 ~~Section 572.002, Government Code]~~, or the spouse of a federal or
 1-44 state judge, beginning on the date the Office of Court
 1-45 Administration of the Texas Judicial System notifies the appraisal
 1-46 district of the judge's qualification for the judge's office.

1-47 SECTION 3. Section 521.121(c), Transportation Code, is
 1-48 amended to read as follows:

1-49 (c) The department shall establish a procedure, on a license
 1-50 holder's qualification for office as a federal or state judge as
 1-51 defined by Section 13.0021, Election Code ~~[572.002, Government~~
 1-52 ~~Code]~~, to omit the residence address of the judge and the spouse of
 1-53 the judge on the license holder's license and to include, in lieu of
 1-54 that address, the street address of the courthouse in which the
 1-55 license holder or license holder's spouse serves as a federal judge
 1-56 or state judge.

1-57 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
