- 10 Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), a [A] county shall accept
- 11 any bids or proposals submitted in hard-copy format.
- 12 (c-1) A commissioners court of a county may by order require
- 13 submission of bids or proposals under this subchapter through
- 14 <u>electronic transmission</u>.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
