 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to waiving the fee for the issuance of a duplicate,
 1-20 modified, or renewed license to carry a handgun for school
 1-21 marshals.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 411.1954 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 411.1954. WAIVER OF CERTAIN FEES FOR SCHOOL MARSHALS.

1-26 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, the
 1-27 department shall waive any fee required for the issuance of a
 1-28 duplicate, modified, or renewed license under this subchapter if
 1-29 the applicant for the license is currently appointed as a school
 1-30 marshal under Section 37.0811, 37.0813, or 51.220, Education Code.

1-31 (b) The applicant must submit with the application
 1-32 materials proof of:

1-33 (1) active status as a school marshal; and

1-34 (2) current licensure under Section 1701.260,
 1-35 Occupations Code.

1-36 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-37 to an application for a duplicate, modified, or renewed license to
 1-38 carry a handgun submitted on or after the effective date of this
 1-39 Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act
 1-40 is governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted,
 1-41 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
