5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 33.910 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 33.910. CHAPLAINS. (a) A school district or
8	open-enrollment charter school may employ chaplains or provide
9	volunteer chaplains at district or school campuses to assist:
10	(1) district or school students, parents, teachers,
11	staff, and administrators with stress management; or
12	(2) school counselors or social workers with

- 14 <u>(b) A chaplain who is employed by or serves as a volunteer at</u>
 15 <u>a school district or open-enrollment charter school under this</u>
 16 <u>section is immune from civil liability to the same extent as a</u>
 17 professional employee of a school district under Subchapter B,
- 18 Chapter 22.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
