## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to funding for the economic stabilization fund, including
- 3 the rates of severance taxes on oil and gas production.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 201.052, Tax Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (b) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the [The] tax
- 9 imposed by this chapter is at the rate of 7.5 percent of the market
- 10 value of gas produced and saved in this state by the producer.
- 11 (b) The rate of tax on gas production described by
- 12 <u>Subsection (a) is subject to Section 49-g(c-6)</u>, Article III, Texas
- 13 Constitution.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 202.052, Tax Code, is amended by
- 15 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read
- 16 as follows:
- 17 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the [The] tax
- 18 imposed by this chapter is at the rate of 4.6 percent of the market
- 19 value of oil produced in this state or 4.6 cents for each barrel of
- 20 42 standard gallons of oil produced in this state, whichever rate
- 21 results in the greater amount of tax.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (d), for [For] oil
- 23 produced in this state from a new or expanded enhanced recovery
- 24 project that qualifies under Section 202.054 of this code, the rate

- 1 of the tax imposed by this chapter is 2.3 percent of the market
- 2 value of the oil.
- 3 (d) The rates of tax on oil production described by
- 4 Subsections (a) and (b) are subject to Section 49-g(c-5), Article
- 5 III, Texas Constitution.
- 6 SECTION 3. The heading to Subchapter H, Chapter 316,
- 7 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER H. <u>STATE HIGHWAY [PRESERVATION OF SUFFICIENT BALANCE</u>
- 9 <u>IN ECONOMIC STABILIZATION</u>] FUND
- SECTION 4. Section 404.0241(c), Government Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (c) The comptroller shall include the fair market value of
- 13 the investment portfolio of the economic stabilization fund in
- 14 calculating the amount in the fund for purposes of Section 49-g(g),
- 15 Article III, Texas Constitution[, and Section 316.093 of this
- 16 <del>code</del>l.
- 17 SECTION 5. The following provisions of the Government Code
- 18 are repealed:
- 19 (1) Sections 316.091, 316.092, and 316.093; and
- 20 (2) Sections 404.0241(a) and (d).
- 21 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect January 1, 2020, but only
- 22 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 86th Legislature,
- 23 Regular Session, 2019, providing for foregoing the transfer of oil
- 24 and gas production tax revenue to the economic stabilization fund
- 25 if the ending fund balance for the preceding fiscal year is greater
- 26 than \$5 billion and for reducing the rates of oil and gas production
- 27 taxes by amounts sufficient to equal the foregone transfer is

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- 1 approved by the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the
- 2 voters, this Act has no effect.
