10	POSTAL SERVICE DURING STATE OF DISASTER. (a) The division shall
11	conduct a study to examine the feasibility of establishing an
12	agreement with the United States Postal Service regarding the use
13	of employees, resources, and assets within the postal service
14	during a state of disaster to:
15	(1) identify residential or commercial structures
16	that have been damaged;
17	(2) identify persons who reside in a damaged area and
18	the medical or physical needs of those persons;
19	(3) help assess the damage to neighborhoods or
20	<pre>communities; and</pre>
21	(4) assist in any other activity that the division
22	determines to be necessary in responding to the disaster.
