5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 28.02123 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 28.02123. NOTIFICATION OF CERTAIN HIGH SCHOOL
8	GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS. (a) Not later than September 1 of each
9	school year, a school district shall notify by regular mail or
10	e-mail the parent of or other person standing in parental relation
11	to each student enrolled in grade nine or above that the student is
12	not required to complete an Algebra II course to graduate under the
13	foundation high school program.
14	(b) The notification must include information regarding the
15	potential consequences to a student of not completing an Algebra II
16	course, including the impact on eligibility for:
17	(1) automatic college admission under Section 51.803;
18	and
19	(2) certain financial aid authorized under Title 3,
20	including:
21	(A) the TEXAS grant program under Subchapter M,
22	Chapter 56; and
23	(B) the Texas Educational Opportunity Grant
24	Program under Subchapter P, Chapter 56.

SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
school year.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
