Sections 37.0811(d) and (e), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (d) Any written regulations adopted for purposes of Subsection (c) must provide that a [school marshal may carry a 8 concealed handgun as described by Subsection (c), except that if 9 the primary duty of the school marshal involves regular, direct 10 contact with students, the marshal may not carry a concealed 11 12 handgun but may possess a handgun on the physical premises of a school in a locked and secured safe within the marshal's immediate 13 14 reach when conducting the marshal's primary duty. The written regulations must also require that a] handgun carried or possessed 15 16 by [or within access of] a school marshal may be loaded only with frangible duty ammunition approved for that purpose by the Texas 17 Commission on Law Enforcement. 18 (e) A school marshal may use [access] a handgun the school 19 marshal is authorized to carry or possess under this section only 20 21 under circumstances that would justify the use of deadly force

22 under Section 9.32 or 9.33, Penal Code.

23 SECTION 2. Sections 37.0813(d) and (e), Education Code, are 24 amended to read as follows:

The written regulations must also require that a] handgun 9 carried or possessed by [or within access of] a school marshal may 10 be loaded only with frangible duty ammunition approved for that 11 purpose by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement. 12

(e) A school marshal may <u>use</u> [access] a handgun <u>the school</u>
<u>marshal is authorized to carry or possess</u> under this section only
under circumstances that would justify the use of deadly force
under Section 9.32 or 9.33, Penal Code.

SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020school year.

19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
