- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.0811(a), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board of trustees of a school district or the
- 8 governing body of an open-enrollment charter school may appoint one
- 9 or more school marshals for each campus [not more than the greater
- 10 of:
- 11 [(1) one school marshal per 200 students in average
- 12 daily attendance per campus; or
- [(2) for each campus, one school marshal per building of
- 14 the campus at which students regularly receive classroom
- 15 <u>instruction</u>].
- SECTION 2. Section 37.0813(a), Education Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The governing body of a private school may appoint one
- 19 <u>or more school marshals</u> [not more than the greater of:
- 20 [(1) one school marshal per 200 students enrolled in
- 21 the school; or
- 22 [(2) one school marshal per building of the school at
- 23 which students regularly receive classroom instruction].
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020

- 1 school year.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
