23	(F) the Department of State Health Services.
24	Sec. 418.128. STATE AGENCY HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS.

(a) Not later than the 30th day after the date the governor issues 1 2 a proclamation under Section 418.127, the governor, in consultation 3 with the division and each appropriate state agency as determined by the governor, shall publish on the office of the governor's 4 5 Internet website a report on the preparedness of state agencies for hurricane response. The report must include: 6 7 (1) a list of each state agency involved in this 8 state's response to a hurricane; 9 (2) contact information for each state agency in the event of a hurricane, including the name, e-mail address, and 10 11 telephone number of the officer or employee who manages the state agency's response to a hurricane; and 12 13 (3) whether the officer or employee under Subdivision (2) has completed the emergency management training course 14 described by Section 418.005. 15 16 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the governor may, by 17 executive order, take any action necessary to ensure each state agency listed under Subsection (a)(1) is able to respond to a 18 hurricane. An executive order issued under this subsection must be 19 20 published in the Texas Register and expires on the last day of the first regular session of the legislature to convene after the date 21 the order is issued unless the governor specifies an earlier 22 23 expiration date in the order. (c) In this section, "response" includes any activity 24 related to the prevention or discovery of, response to, or recovery 25 26 from a hurricane. 27 Sec. 418.129. HOUSING ASSISTANCE INFORMATION. 1	Land Office shall conduct a public information campaign each year
2	before and during hurricane season to provide local officials and
3	the public with information regarding housing assistance that may
4	be available under state and federal law in the event of a major
5	hurricane or flooding event, including information about types of
