## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to information, outreach, and other actions regarding hurricane preparedness and mitigation. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 418, Government Code, is 5 amended by adding Sections 418.127, 418.128, and 418.129 to read as 6 7 follows: Sec. 418.127. HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS. The governor shall 8 9 issue a proclamation each year before hurricane season instructing: (1) individuals, including residential and commercial 10 property owners, to prepare their property and communities for the 11 upcoming hurricane season; 12 13 (2) state agencies to review and update their 14 hurricane preparedness plans; and 15 (3) the following entities, to the extent practicable, 16 to conduct community outreach and education activities on hurricane preparedness between May 25 and May 31 of each year: 17 18 (A) municipalities and counties; 19 (B) the division; the Texas Education Agency; 20 (C) 21 (D) the office of the comptroller; the Texas Department of Insurance; and 22 (E) 23 (F) the Department of State Health Services. Sec. 418.128. STATE AGENCY HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS. (a) 24

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C.S.S.B. No. 285 1 Not later than the 30th day after the date the governor issues a proclamation under Section 418.127, the governor, in consultation 2 3 with the division and each appropriate state agency as determined by the governor, shall publish on the office of the governor's 4 5 Internet website a report on the preparedness of state agencies for hurricane response. The report must include: 6 7 (1) a list of each state agency involved in this 8 state's response to a hurricane; (2) contact information for each state agency in the 9 event of a hurricane, including the name, e-mail address, and 10 telephone number of the officer or employee who manages the state 11 12 agency's response to a hurricane; and (3) whether the officer or employee under Subdivision 13 14 (2) has completed the emergency management training course described by Section 418.005. 15 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the governor may, by 16 17 executive order, take any action necessary to ensure each state agency listed under Subsection (a)(1) is able to respond to a 18 19 hurricane. An executive order issued under this subsection must be published in the Texas Register and expires on the last day of the 20 first regular session of the legislature to convene after the date 21 22 the order is issued unless the governor specifies an earlier 23 expiration date in the order. 24 (c) In this section, "response" includes any activity related to the prevention or discovery of, response to, or recovery 25 26 from a hurricane.
