9	SECTION 2. Section 37.020, Education Code, is amended by
10	adding Subsections (f) and (g) to read as follows:
11	(f) For each suspension under Section 37.005, the district

15	is in a special education program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, or
16	covered by Section 504, Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C.

18	with information collected through other reports;
19	(2) information indicating the basis for the

21	(3) the number of full or partial days the student was

23	(4) the number of suspensions that were inconsistent

2 (g) The agency shall make information collected under this section, disaggregated by race, sex, and age of the student and 3 whether the student is in a special education program under 4 Subchapter A, Chapter 29, or covered by Section 504, Rehabilitation 5 Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. Section 794), available to the public in a 6 manner that does not identify an individual student. The agency 7 8 shall also make the information available to the public in a manner 9 showing all intersectional data for the categories described by 10 this subsection.

SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 school year.

13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
