- 7 Sec. 22.0518. DEFENSE BY ATTORNEY GENERAL. (a) The
- 8 attorney general shall defend a civil action brought against a
- 9 teacher employed by a school district or open-enrollment charter
- 10 school as a result of an act that the teacher in good faith believed
- 11 was incident to or within the scope of the teacher's duties if the
- 12 attorney general determines that the teacher acted in good faith.
- (b) Subsection (a) applies regardless of whether at the time
- 14 the action is initiated the teacher has terminated service with the
- 15 school district or open-enrollment charter school.
- (c) A determination made by the attorney general under
- 17 Subsection (a) may not be admitted as evidence in a civil court
- 18 proceeding.
- 19 <u>(d) Nothing in this section may be construed to deprive a</u>
- 20 teacher of the teacher's right to select legal counsel of the
- 21 teacher's choosing at the teacher's own expense.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 22.0518, Education Code, as added by

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
