A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue in certain municipalities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 351.1066(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) This section applies only to: a municipality with a population of at least 3,500 8 (1) but less than 5,500 that is the county seat of a county with a 9 population of less than 50,000 that borders a county with a 10 population of more than 1.6 million; 11 12 (2) a municipality with a population of at least 2,900 but less than 3,500 that is the county seat of a county with a 13 population of less than 22,000 that is bordered by the Trinity River 14 and includes a state park and a portion of a wildlife management 15 16 area; a municipality with a population of at least 7,500 17 (3) that is located in a county that borders the Pecos River and that 18 has a population of not more than 15,000; 19 20 (4) a municipality with a population of not more than 21 15,000 [5,000] that is located in a county through which the Frio River flows and an interstate highway crosses, and that has a 22 population of at least 15,000; and 23 (5) a municipality with a population of not less than 24

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1 7,500 that is located in a county with a population of not less than 2 40,000 but less than 250,000 that is adjacent to a county with a 3 population of less than 750.

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4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
