## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1-21 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue in 1-22 certain municipalities. 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 351.1066(a), Tax Code, is amended to 1-24 1-25 read as follows: 1-26

(a) This section applies only to:

(1) a municipality with a population of at least 3,500 but less than 5,500 that is the county seat of a county with a population of less than 50,000 that borders a county with a 1-27 1-28 1-29 population of more than 1.6 million; 1-30

(2) a municipality with a population of at least 2,900 but less than 3,500 that is the county seat of a county with a population of less than 22,000 that is bordered by the Trinity River 1-31 1-32 1-33 1-34 and includes a state park and a portion of a wildlife management 1-35 area;

(3) a municipality with a population of at least 7,500 that is located in a county that borders the Pecos River and that has a population of not more than 15,000; 1-36 1-37 1-38

(4) a municipality with a population of not more than 15,000 [5,000] that is located in a county through which the Frio River flows and an interstate highway crosses, and that has a 1-39 1-40 1-41 population of at least 15,000; and 1-42

1-43 (5) a municipality with a population of not less than 1-44 7,500 that is located in a county with a population of not less than 1-45 40,000 but less than 250,000 that is adjacent to a county with a 1-46 population of less than 750.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-47 1-48 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-49 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-50 1-51 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
