5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 772, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 772.0078 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 772.0078. OPIOID ANTAGONIST GRANT PROGRAM. (a) In

9	(1) "Criminal justice division" means the criminal
10	justice division established under Section 772.006.
11	(2) "Opioid antagonist" and "opioid-related drug
12	overdose" have the meanings assigned by Section 483.101, Health and

- 14 <u>(b) The criminal justice division shall establish and</u>
 15 administer a grant program to provide financial assistance to a law
- 16 enforcement agency in this state that seeks to provide opioid
- 17 antagonists to peace officers, evidence technicians, and related
- 18 personnel who, in the course of performing their duties, are likely
- 19 to come into contact with opioids or encounter persons suffering
- 20 from an apparent opioid-related drug overdose.
- 21 <u>(c)</u> A law enforcement agency may apply for a grant under
- 22 this section only if the agency first adopts a policy addressing the
- 23 usage of an opioid antagonist for a person suffering from an
- 24 apparent opioid-related drug overdose.

- 1 (d) In an application for a grant under this section, the
- 2 law enforcement agency shall provide information to the criminal
- 3 justice division about the frequency and nature of:
- 4 (1) interactions between peace officers and persons
- 5 suffering from an apparent opioid-related drug overdose;
- 6 (2) calls for assistance based on an apparent
- 7 opioid-related drug overdose; and
- 8 (3) any exposure of peace officers, evidence
- 9 technicians, or related personnel to opioids or suspected opioids
- 10 in the course of performing their duties and any reactions by those
- 11 persons to those substances.
- 12 <u>(e) A law enforcement agency rec</u>eiving a grant under this
- 13 section shall, as soon as practicable after receiving the grant,
- 14 provide to the criminal justice division proof of purchase of the
- 15 opioid antagonists.
- 16 (f) The criminal justice division may use any money
- 17 available for purposes of this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
