 16 remain natural, scenic, undeveloped, and open in a manner that
 17 maintains the tree canopy cover of the forest. No statute, rule,
 18 policy, or ordinance may be enforced with respect to the territory
 19 of the Jones State Forest, other than a statute, rule, policy, or
 20 ordinance that protects and conserves the natural resources, air
 21 quality, or water quality of the Jones State Forest.
