Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Sections 28.0047 and 28.0048 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 28.0047. MODEL RECESS POLICIES. The Department of 7 State Health Services School Health Advisory Committee established under Section 1001.0711, Health and Safety Code, shall develop 8 9 model policies for the recess period during the school day that encourage constructive, age-appropriate outdoor playtime. 10 model policies must include guidelines for outdoor equipment and 11 facilities on public school campuses that maximize 12 the effectiveness of outdoor physical activity. 13

- 14 <u>Sec. 28.0048. RECESS POLICY. (a) The board of trustees of</u> 15 each school district shall:
- 16 (1) after reviewing the model recess policies
- 17 developed under Section 28.0047 and the policy recommendations of

- 19 28.004(1), adopt a recess policy based on those model policies and
- 20 recommendations; and

- 2 (2) whether a student's recess time may be withheld as

- 7 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2020, the
- 8 Department of State Health Services School Health Advisory
- 9 Committee shall develop model recess policies as required by

- 11 (b) Not later than May 1, 2020, the board of trustees of each
- 12 school district shall adopt a recess policy as required by Section

- 14 (c) Not later than the beginning of the 2020-2021 school
- 15 year, each school district campus subject to a school district
- 16 recess policy adopted under Section 28.0048, Education Code, as

- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
