- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 12.104, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-1) The governing body of an open-enrollment charter</u>
- 9 school may:
- 10 (1) employ security personnel and commission peace
- 11 officers in the same manner as a board of trustees of a school
- 12 district under Section 37.081; and
- (2) enter into a memorandum of understanding with a
- 14 <u>local law enforcement agency to assign a school resource officer,</u>
- 15 as that term is defined by Section 1701.601, Occupations Code, to
- 16 the school.
- 17 (a-2) A reference in law to a peace officer commissioned
- 18 under Section 37.081 includes a peace officer commissioned by an
- 19 open-enrollment charter school in accordance with Subsection
- 20 (a-1), and a charter school peace officer has the same powers,
- 21 duties, and immunities as a peace officer commissioned under that
- 22 section.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
