| 11 | (1) is a citizen of the United States; and |
| 12 | (2) satisfies all other requirements to be licensed in |
| 13 | this state. |
| 14 | (b) An attorney eligible to take the examination under this |
| 15 | section must comply with the procedures and deadlines prescribed by |
| 16 | the supreme court. |
| 17 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. |
