Sections 30A.002(a) and (c), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 7 (a) A student is eligible to enroll in one or more courses [a course] provided through the state virtual school network or, 8 except as provided by Section 30A.107(c), enroll full-time in 9 courses provided through the network only if the student: 10

- 11 (1) on September 1 of the school year:
- 12 (A) is younger than 21 years of age; or
- 13 (B) is younger than 26 years of age and entitled
- 14 to the benefits of the Foundation School Program under Section
- 15 42.003;
- 16 (2) has not graduated from high school; and
- 17 (3) is otherwise eligible to enroll in a public school
- 18 in this state.
- (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(3) [or (b)], a student
- 20 is eligible to enroll in one or more courses provided through the
- 21 state virtual school network or enroll full-time in courses
- 22 provided through the network if the student:
- 23 (1) is a dependent of a member of the United States
- 24 military;

- 1 (2) was previously enrolled in high school in this
- 2 state; and
- 3 (3) does not reside in this state due to a military
- 4 deployment or transfer.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 30A.002(b), Education Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 7 school year.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
