- 2 relating to toll collections and enforcement by a toll project
- 3 entity.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 284.209, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 284.209. ENFORCEMENT OF DECISION. A decision issued
- 8 under Section 284.208(a) may be enforced by:
- 9 (1) placing a device that prohibits movement of a
- 10 motor vehicle on the vehicle that is the subject of the decision; or
- 11 (2) imposing an additional fine if the fine for the
- 12 offense is not paid within a specified time $[\frac{}{\tau}]$ or
- 13 [(3) refusing to allow the registration of the
- 14 vehicle].
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 366.038(h), Transportation Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (h) For purposes of Subchapter C, Chapter 372, a toll
- 18 project for which an authority provides tolling services under a
- 19 tolling services agreement is considered a toll project of the
- 20 authority and the authority is considered the toll project entity
- 21 with respect to all rights and remedies arising under that
- 22 subchapter regarding the toll project. The authority may not stop
- 23 [, detain, or impound] a motor vehicle as authorized under that
- 24 subchapter on a toll project's active traffic lanes unless a

- 1 tolling service agreement addresses that action.
- 2 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 372, Transportation Code,
- 3 is amended by adding Sections 372.054 and 372.055 to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 Sec. 372.054. INITIAL TOLL INVOICE SENT BY MAIL OR
- 6 ELECTRONIC MEANS. (a) This section applies only to a toll project
- 7 entity that, as an alternative to requiring payment of a toll at the
- 8 <u>time a vehicle is driven or towed through a toll assessment</u>
- 9 facility, uses video recordings, photography, electronic data,
- 10 transponders, or other tolling methods to permit the registered
- 11 owner of a nonpaying vehicle to pay the toll at a later date.
- 12 (b) A toll project entity that sends by first class mail or
- 13 <u>electronic means to the registered owner of a vehicle an initial</u>
- 14 invoice containing an assessment for use of a toll project by the
- 15 vehicle may not assess an additional fee other than a postage fee to
- 16 the amount owed by the owner of the vehicle.
- 17 Sec. 372.055. NOTICE OF RETURNED PAYMENT. A toll project
- 18 entity must immediately notify the holder of an electronic toll
- 19 collection customer account that a payment by the credit card or
- 20 debit card associated with the account was declined or could not
- 21 otherwise be processed.
- SECTION 4. Section 372.109(b), Transportation Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- (b) When a determination terminates, the toll project
- 25 entity shall, not later than the seventh day after the date of the
- 26 termination, send notice of the termination[+
- [(1)] to the person who is the subject of the

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- 1 determination at an address under Section 372.106(b)[; and
- 2 [(2) if the toll project entity provided notice to a
- 3 county assessor-collector or the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles
- 4 under Section 502.011, to that county assessor-collector or that
- 5 department, as appropriate].
- 6 SECTION 5. Sections 284.070(c), 372.111, 372.112, and
- 7 502.011, Transportation Code, are repealed.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
