5	SECTION 1. Section 825.402, Government Code, is amended to

24	(6) 6.7 percent of the member's annual compensation

9	percent for each one-tenth of one percent that the state
10	contribution rate for the fiscal year to which the service relates

13	(12) for compensation paid on or after September 1,
14	2021, and before September 1, 2022, the lesser of:
15	(A) 8.75 percent of the member's annual

compensation equal to nine percent reduced by one-tenth of one 1 percent for each one-tenth of one percent that the state 2 3 contribution rate for the fiscal year to which the service relates 4 is less than the state contribution rate established for the 2015 5 fiscal year; 6 (14) for compensation paid on or after September 1, 7 2023, and before September 1, 2024, the lesser of: 8 (A) 9.25 percent of the member's annual 9 compensation; or (B) a percentage of the member's annual 10 11 compensation equal to 9.25 percent reduced by one-tenth of one percent for each one-tenth of one percent that the state 12 13 contribution rate for the fiscal year to which the service relates is less than the state contribution rate established for the 2015 14 fiscal year; and 15 16 (15) for compensation paid on or after September 1, 17 2024, the lesser of: 18 (A) 9.5 percent of the member's annual 19 compensation; or 20 (B) a percentage of the member's annual compensation equal to 9.5 percent reduced by one-tenth of one 21 percent for each one-tenth of one percent that the state 22 contribution rate for the fiscal year to which the service relates 23 is less than the state contribution rate established for the 2015 24 f<u>iscal year</u>. 25 SECTION 2. 26 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 825, Government Code, 18 27 amended by adding Section 825.4021 to read as follows:

1	(a) All members of the retirement system excluding
2	full-time classroom teachers shall receive successive permanent
3	raises according to the following schedule:
4	(1) 0.55 percent of annual compensation paid on or
5	after September 1, 2019;
6	(2) 0.25 percent of annual compensation paid on or
7	after September 1, 2020;
8	(3) 0.25 percent of annual compensation paid on or
9	after September 1, 2021;
10	(4) 0.25 percent of annual compensation paid on or
11	after September 1, 2022;
12	(5) 0.25 percent of annual compensation paid on or
13	after September 1, 2023; and
14	(6) 0.25 percent of annual compensation paid on or
15	after September 1, 2024.
16	(b) The raises described in Subsection (a) are not
17	considered in determining whether the employer is paying the member
18	the applicable minimum monthly salary as set forth in the Education
19	Code, if any.
20	(c) The state shall increase its annual aid to each employer
21	in an amount sufficient to fund the raises described in Subsection

23	SECTION 3. Section 825.4035, Government Code, is amended by
24	adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
25	(e) The 1.5 percent rate of contribution contained in this
26	section shall increase as follows:
27	(1) beginning with the report month for September

1	2020, the contribution rate shall increase to 1.6 percent;
2	(2) beginning with the report month for September
3	2021, the contribution rate shall increase to 1.7 percent;
4	(3) beginning with the report month for September
5	2022, the contribution rate shall increase to 1.8 percent;
6	(4) beginning with the report month for September
7	2023, the contribution rate shall increase to 1.9 percent; and
8	(5) beginning with the report month for September
9	2024, the contribution rate shall increase to two percent.
10	SECTION 4. Section 825.404(a), Government Code, is amended
11	to read as follows:
12	(a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), during each
13	fiscal year, the state shall contribute to the retirement system an
14	amount equal to at least six and not more than 10 percent of the
15	aggregate annual compensation of all members of the retirement
16	system during that fiscal year <u>according to Subsection (f)</u> .
17	SECTION 5. Section 825.404, Government Code, is amended by
18	adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
19	(f) The state will make contributions to the retirement
20	system according to the following rates:
21	(1) seven percent beginning on September 1, 2019;
22	(2) 7.2 percent beginning on September 1, 2020;
23	(3) 7.4 percent beginning on September 1, 2021;
24	(4) 7.6 percent beginning on September 1, 2022;
25	(5) 7.8 percent beginning on September 1, 2023; and
26	(6) eight percent beginning on September 1, 2024.
27	SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
