- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is 5
- amended by adding Section 54.53971 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 54.53971. INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS FEES; TEXAS A&M 7
- UNIVERSITY--SAN ANTONIO. (a) The board of regents of The Texas A&M 8
- 9 University System may impose on each student enrolled at Texas A&M
- University--San Antonio an intercollegiate athletics fee in an 10
- amount not to exceed \$10 per semester credit hour for each regular 11
- 12 semester or summer session unless the amount of the fee is increased
- as provided by Subsection (c). 13

- 14 (b) The fee may not be imposed unless approved by a majority
- vote of the students of the university who participate in a general 15
- 16 student election held for that purpose.
- (c) The amount of the fee per semester credit hour may be 17
- increased from one academic year to the next only if approved by a 18
- majority vote of the students participating in a general student 19
- election held for that purpose or, if the amount of the increase 20
- does not exceed five percent, by a majority vote of the legislative 21
- body of the student government of the university. 22
- 23 (d) A student enrolled in more than 12 semester credit hours
- shall pay the fee in an amount equal to the amount imposed on a 24

- 1 student enrolled in 12 semester credit hours during the same
- 2 <u>semester or session.</u>
- 3 (e) A fee imposed under this section may be used to develop
- 4 and maintain an intercollegiate athletics program at the
- 5 <u>university.</u>
- 6 (f) A fee imposed under this section is in addition to any
- 7 other fee authorized by law and may not be considered in determining
- 8 the amount of student services fees that may be imposed under
- 9 Section 54.503.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019 fall
- 11 semester.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
