1 AN ACT 2 relating to legislative oversight of deferred maintenance 3 projects. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter I, Chapter 2165, 5 Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER I. DEFERRED MAINTENANCE FUNDING [FUND] 7 SECTION 2. Subchapter I, Chapter 2165, Government Code, is 8 amended by adding Section 2165.404 to read as follows: 9 Sec. 2165.404. JOINT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT 10 FACILITIES. (a) In this section, "committee" means the Joint 11 Oversight Committee on Government Facilities. 12 13 (b) The committee is created to review deferred maintenance plans and receive implementation updates. 14 15 (c) The committee is composed of six members as follows: (1) three members of the senate appointed by the 16 17 lieutenant governor; and (2) three members of the house of representatives 18 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives. 19 (d) The chair of the committee shall alternate annually 20 21 between:

(1) a member of the senate appointed by the lieutenant

(2) a member of the house of representatives appointed

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governor; and

- 1 by the speaker of the house of representatives.
- 2 (e) The lieutenant governor shall appoint the first chair of
- 3 the committee.
- 4 (f) A vacancy on the committee shall be filled in the same
- 5 manner as the original appointment.
- 6 (g) The committee biannually shall provide a written report
- 7 to the legislature that identifies:
- 8 <u>(1) the amount of money expended for deferred</u>
- 9 maintenance;
- 10 (2) planned deferred maintenance projects; and
- 11 (3) the status of ongoing and completed deferred
- 12 maintenance projects.
- 13 (h) The committee shall:
- 14 <u>(1) have the powers and duties of a joint committee</u>
- 15 created by proclamation; and
- 16 (2) obtain funding in the same manner as a joint
- 17 committee created by proclamation.
- 18 (i) The rules adopted by the 86th Legislature for the
- 19 administration of joint committees created by proclamation apply to
- 20 the committee to the extent the rules are consistent with this
- 21 section.
- 22 (j) The committee is abolished and this section expires on
- 23 September 1, 2025.
- SECTION 3. (a) If this Act receives the votes necessary
- 25 for immediate effect, the lieutenant governor and the speaker of
- 26 the house of representatives shall make appointments to the Joint
- 27 Oversight Committee on Government Facilities not later than July 1,

- 1 2019.
- 2 (b) If this Act does not receive the votes necessary for
- 3 immediate effect, the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the
- 4 house of representatives shall make appointments to the Joint
- 5 Oversight Committee on Government Facilities not later than
- 6 September 15, 2019.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
