 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the criminal offense of making a false report to a peace
 1-18 officer, federal special investigator, law enforcement employee,
 1-19 corrections officer, or jailer.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 37.08, Penal Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 37.08. FALSE REPORT TO PEACE OFFICER, FEDERAL SPECIAL
 1-24 INVESTIGATOR, ~~OR~~ LAW ENFORCEMENT EMPLOYEE, CORRECTIONS OFFICER,
 1-25 OR JAILER.

1-26 SECTION 2. Section 37.08(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
 1-27 as follows:

1-28 (a) A person commits an offense if, with intent to deceive,
 1-29 he knowingly makes a false statement that is material to a criminal
 1-30 investigation and makes the statement to:

1-31 (1) a peace officer or federal special investigator
 1-32 conducting the investigation; ~~or~~

1-33 (2) any employee of a law enforcement agency that is
 1-34 authorized by the agency to conduct the investigation and that the
 1-35 actor knows is conducting the investigation; or

1-36 (3) a corrections officer or jailer.

1-37 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-38 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
 1-39 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
 1-40 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
 1-41 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
 1-42 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
 1-43 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
 1-44 before that date.

1-45 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
