1 district created under the authority of Section 59, Article XVI,
2 Texas Constitution, as a regional water management entity to

5 (b) For each river authority for which the governor was not 6 required to designate a presiding officer of the board of directors 7 for that river authority before the effective date of this Act, the 8 governor shall designate a presiding officer of the board of 9 directors of the river authority not later than January 31, 2020.
