- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 531.02253 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 531.02253. COMPREHENSIVE WORKFORCE PLAN FOR MENTAL
- 9 HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE. (a) The statewide behavioral health
- 10 coordinating council, under the direction of the commission, shall
- 11 develop and the commission shall implement a comprehensive plan to
- 12 <u>increase and improve the workforce in this state to serve persons</u>
- 13 with mental health and substance use issues. In developing the
- 14 plan, the council shall analyze and consider available studies,
- 15 reports, and recommendations regarding that segment of the
- 16 workforce in this state or elsewhere.
- 17 (b) The plan must include:
- 18 (1) a strategy and timeline for implementing the plan,
- 19 <u>including short-term, medium-term, and long-term goals;</u>
- 20 (2) a system for monitoring the implementation of the
- 21 plan; and
- 22 (3) a method for evaluating the outcomes of the plan.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2020, the statewide
- 24 behavioral health coordinating council shall develop and the Health

- 1 and Human Services Commission shall begin implementing the plan
- 2 required under Section 531.02253, Government Code, as added by this
- 3 Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. The statewide behavioral health coordinating
- 5 council and the Health and Human Services Commission are required
- 6 to implement a provision of this Act only if the legislature
- 7 appropriates money to the commission specifically for that purpose.
- 8 If the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 9 purpose, the council and the commission may, but are not required
- 10 to, implement the provision using other appropriations made to the
- 11 commission that are available for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
