- 9 person may not use a wireless communication device within 100 feet

- 11 (b) A person may not use any mechanical or electronic means

- 14 (e) A person may use the person's mobile phone to access

- SECTION 2. The heading to Section 62.0111, Election Code,
- 17 is amended to read as follows:

- SECTION 3. Section 62.0111(a), Election Code, is amended to

- 1 one or more locations in the polling place where it can be read by
- 2 persons waiting to vote.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
