| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:              |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Chapter 1251, Government Code, is amended by              |
| 6  | designating Sections 1251.001, 1251.002, 1251.003, 1251.004,         |
| 7  | 1251.005, and 1251.006 as Subchapter A and adding a subchapter       |
| 8  | heading to read as follows:  |
| 9  | SUBCHAPTER A. PROVISIONS RELATING GENERALLY TO COUNTY AND            |
| 10 | MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTIONS   |
| 11 | SECTION 2. Chapter 1251, Government Code, is amended by              |
| 12 | adding Subchapter B to read as follows:                              |
| 13 | SUBCHAPTER B. BALLOT FOR BONDS ISSUED BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION       |
| 14 | Sec. 1251.051. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:                      |
| 15 | (1) "Debt obligation" means an issued public security,               |
| 16 | as defined by Section 1201.002, that is secured by ad valorem taxes. |
| 17 | (2) "Political subdivision" means a county,                          |
| 18 | municipality, school district, junior college district, other        |
| 19 | special district, or other subdivision of state government.          |
| 20 | Sec. 1251.052. CONTENTS OF BALLOT PROPOSITION. The                   |
| 21 | proposition submitted for an election to authorize a political       |
| 22 | subdivision to issue debt obligations must distinctly state:         |
| 23 | (1) the purpose for which the debt obligations are to                |
| 24 | be authorized;   |

- 1 (2) the principal amount of the debt obligations to be
- 2 <u>authorized;</u>
- 3 (3) that taxes sufficient to pay the annual principal
- 4 of and interest on the debt obligations may be imposed;
- 5 (4) the aggregate amount of the outstanding principal
- 6 of the political subdivision's debt obligations as of the beginning
- 7 of the political subdivision's fiscal year in which the election is
- 8 ordered; and
- 9 <u>(5) the ad valorem debt service tax rate for the</u>
- 10 political subdivision at the time the election is ordered,
- 11 expressed as:
- (A) an amount per \$100 valuation of taxable
- 13 property; and
- 14 (B) a percentage of the political subdivision's
- 15 adopted tax rate as of the beginning of the political subdivision's
- 16 <u>fiscal year in which the election is ordered.</u>
- Sec. 1251.053. FORM OF BALLOT. The secretary of state may
- 18 adopt a form of the ballot for an election held under this
- 19 subchapter. A political subdivision is not required to use any
- 20 adopted form.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 1251.052, Government Code, as added by
- 22 this Act, applies only to an election ordered on or after the
- 23 effective date of this Act. An election ordered before the
- 24 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 25 election was ordered, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 26 that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
