A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to vehicle eligibility for the light-duty motor vehicle purchase or lease incentive program. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 386.154(d), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 A new light-duty motor vehicle powered by an electric 7 (d) drive is eligible for a \$2,500 incentive if the vehicle: 8 9 (1) has four wheels or is a motorcycle as defined by 541.201, Transportation Code; 10 11 (2) was manufactured for use primarily on public 12 streets, roads, and highways; 13 (3) has not been modified from the original 14 manufacturer's specifications; 15 (4) has a maximum speed capability of at least 55 miles 16 per hour; (5) is propelled to a significant extent by 17 an 18 electric motor that draws electricity from a hydrogen fuel cell or from a battery that: 19 20 has a capacity of not less than four kilowatt (A) 21 hours; and 22 (B) is capable of being recharged from an 23 external source of electricity; and (6) was acquired on or after September 1, 2013, or a 24

1 later date as established by the commission, by the person applying 2 for the incentive under this subsection and for use or lease by that 3 person and not for resale.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
