> relating to factors the Texas Historical Commission considers in reviewing an application for a grant or loan through the historic courthouse preservation program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 442.0081(e), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

- In considering whether to grant an application, the (e)commission shall also consider the following factors:
- (1) the amount of money available for a grant or loan and the percentage of the costs that the county or municipality will contribute;
- whether the county or municipality will contribute any in-kind contribution such as labor or materials;
 - (3)the cost to preserve or restore the courthouse;
 - (4)the architectural style of the courthouse;
 - (5) the historic significance of the courthouse;
- the county's or municipality's master preservation (6)
