S.B. No. 522

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 2 relating to the development of an individualized education program 3 for a public school student with a visual impairment.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 30.002, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (f-1) to read as 7 follows:

8 (f) In the development of the individualized education program for a [functionally blind] student with a visual 9 impairment, proficiency in [braille] reading and writing is a 10 significant indicator of [presumed to be essential for] the 11 student's satisfactory educational progress. The individualized 12 13 education program for a student with a visual impairment must include instruction in [Each functionally blind student is entitled 14 15 to] braille and the use of braille unless the student's admission, review, and dismissal committee determines and documents that 16 17 braille is not an appropriate literacy medium for the student. The committee's determination must be based on an evaluation of the 18 student's appropriate literacy media and literacy skills and the 19 student's current and future instructional needs [reading and 20 writing instruction that is sufficient to enable the student to 21 22 communicate with the same level of proficiency as other students of 23 comparable ability who are at the same grade level]. Braille 24 instruction:

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1 <u>(1)</u> may be used in combination with other special 2 education services appropriate to the student's educational needs<u>;</u> 3 <u>and</u>

4 (2) shall be provided by a teacher certified to teach 5 students with visual impairments[. The assessment of each 6 functionally blind student for the purpose of developing the 7 student's individualized education program must include 8 documentation of the student's strengths and weaknesses in braille 9 skills].

(f-1) Each person assisting in the development of the [a 10 11 functionally blind student's] individualized education program for a student with a visual impairment shall receive information 12 13 describing the benefits of braille instruction. [Each functionally blind student's individualized education program must specify the 14 appropriate learning medium based on the assessment report and 15 16 ensure that instruction in braille will be provided by a teacher certified to teach students with visual impairments. For purposes 17 of this subsection, the agency shall determine the criteria for 18 student to be classified as functionally blind.] 19

20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 21 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
