1 follows: 2 Sec. 551.354. PARKING. A person may not park a motor-assisted scooter in a manner that obstructs a roadway, path, 3 4 or sidewalk. Sec. 551.355. EFFECT OF SUBCHAPTER ON OTHER LAW. A county 5 6 or <u>municipality may:</u> 7 (1) further restrict the speed at which a person may 8 operate a motor-assisted scooter; 9 (2) further restrict the locations a person may 10 operate a motor-assisted scooter; (3) increase the minimum age requirement for the 11 12 operator of a motor-assisted scooter; (4) impose a higher criminal or civil penalty for a 13 14 violation of this subchapter; 15 (5) further restrict the locations a person may park a 16 motor-assisted scooter; 17 (6) require the operator of a motor-assisted scooter to wear a safety helmet; or 18 19 (7) prohibit the operation of a motor-assisted scooter on a street, highway, or sidewalk if the governing body of the 20 21 county or municipality determines that the prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety. 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 23
